Kelab Kucing Malaysia FAQ

Apa anda perlu tahu mengenai
pendaftaran dan perpindahan kucing

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1 Bagaimana nak jadi ahli

Isi boring Keahlian KKM. Yuran permulaan ialah RM50. Seterusnya pembaharuan keahlian ialah RM30, dibayar sebelum akhir Disember, bagi keahlian tahun seterusnya.

2 Bagaimana nak jadi Pembiak FIFe

Menjadi Pembiak FIFe hanya hak kepada ahli ahli Kelab yang dibawah naungan FIFe, dimana KKM adalah Kelab naungan FIFe di Malaysia. Anda perlu menjadi ahli KKM untuk mendapat kelayakan tersebut.

Mempunyai kucing di bawah pendaftaran KKM sekurang-kurangnya betina di atas nama anda

Anda perlu mengisi borang FCR – FIFe Cattery Registration – dan hantar ke kkmsecretary@gmail.com

Menjadi pembiak berdaftar KKM mempunyai peraturan dan panduan tersendiri. Pembiak yang baik dan bertanggungjawab akan sentiasa mematuhi dan mengamalkan panduan Etika Pembiak KKM

Rujuk kepada Etika Pembiak KKM

3 Boleh kah saya memiliki kucing berdaftar KKM tanpa menjadi ahli atau pembiak KKM?

Anda boleh memiliki kucing bakatulin berdaftar KKM tanpa menjadi ahli atau pembiak; tetapi tidak boleh mendaftar litter dari kucing betina milik anda.

Kucing anda masih boleh menyertai Pertandingan kucing FIFe untuk mendapatkan sijil sijil untuk memenang Title FIFe.

4 Bagaimana hendak menukar pendaftaran kucing dari kelab lain

Anda perlu ada dokumen berikut:

- Sijil pendaftaran yang asal dari Kelab yang di daftarkan
- Sijil keturunan bakatulin yang asal sekurang-kurangnya 4 generasi
- Sijil pertukaran pemilik dari pembiak/pemilik asal kepada nama anda. Memadai juga jika anda di sahkan pemilik di sijil pendaftaran dan/atau di sijil keturunan bakatulin.

Yuran tambahan dikenakan jika nama pemilik tidak mutlak atau berlainan dari pemohon (sebagai pemili terbaru).

5 Kenapa perlu menukar pendaftaran kucing dari kelab lain ke KKM

Kucing anda boleh memasuki pertandingan kucing FIFe anjuran KKM bagi memperolehi sijil 'Championship' dan 'Titles'

Anak anak kucing kelahiran ibu betina anda boleh di daftarkan dengan sijil pendaftaran dan bakatulin FIFe

6 Apa yang perlu dibuat

Anda patut semak sijil sijil di atas dikeluarkan oleh Kelab yang sah **sebelum** membeli / mengimpot kucing tersebut.

KKM boleh membantu. Hantarkan sijil keturunan bakatulin dan gambar kucing sebelum permohonan perpindahan kelab. Ini mungkin mengambil sedikit masa dan terpulang kepada jawapan dari kelab asal.

7 Bagaimana hendak memindahkan pendaftaran kucing dari kelab lain ke KKM

- Isi boring CRF – bahagian A and C
- Hantarkan boring yang sudah dilengkapi bersama :
 - Sijil sijil kucing dari kelab asal (seperti diatas)
 - Gambar terkini kucing (*lihat contoh*)
 - Gambar terkini kucing bersama pemilik
 - Gambar tambahan akan diminta jika perlu
 - Resit pembayaran yuran



Sila baca arahan dan syarat syarat di bahagian atas borang. Yuran dan cara pembayaran tercatat dibahagian bawah boring tersebut.

Yuran tambahan pertukaran pemilik akan dikenakan jika pemilik asal tidak jelas atau berlainan dari nama pemohon.

8 Berapa lama process perpindahan pendaftaran tersebut

- Semua sijil pendaftaran dan keturunan bakatulin kucing dari kelab asing perlukan pengesahan kesahihan dari kelab asal. Jangkamasa terpulang kepada tindakbalas kelab tersebut yang boleh mengambil sedikit masa. time.
- Purata diantara 60 hari. Tidak perlu untuk email susulan yang akan menyebabkan kelewatan terhadap permohonan tersebut

9 Apa makna LO atau RX dalam sijil pendaftaran kucing

LO – Legal Origin – apabila 3 generasi pertama sijil bakatulin mengandungi kucing kucing dari baka yang sama (atau baka yang dibenarkan) dan dari varieti warna yang diiktiraf, dan mempunyai nombor pendaftaran yang lengkap

RX – Experimental – apabila sijil bakatulin tidak lengkap seperti diatas atau kucing kucing novice yang tidak diketahui asal usul nya

Kedua dua nya boleh bertanding bagi sijil 'Championship' dan 'Title' di pertandingan Antarabangsa FIFe

Kucing RX digalakkan pembiakan dengan kucing dari pendaftaran LO; namun pembiakan dengan kucing RX juga dibenarkan.

10 Bila kah saya boleh mula mendaftarkan litter

Anda perlu memenuhi syarat syarat berikut :

Sudah mempunyai Cattery FIFe dan berdaftar dengan KKM

Sudah memperbaharui keahlian KKM bagi tahun semasa

Ibu ('Dam') kepada litter berdaftar dengan KKM dan hak milik sah Cattery anda

Ibu ('Dam') sudah berdaftar dengan KKM sebelum kelahiran litter

Cattery dimana ibu ('dam') di daftarkan berhak mendaftarkan litter tersebut

11 Bagaimana pula dengan bapa ('sire') kepada litter

Kucing jantan yang berdaftar dengan kelab lain boleh menjadi 'sire' kepada litter, dan KKM perlu diberitahu sebelum dikahwinkan.

- Sijil sijil berikut perlu ada dan mendapat pengesahan kesahihan :
 - Sijil keturunan bakatulin kelab asal
 - Sijil pendaftaran kelab asal dan pengesahan pemilik
 - Gambar terkini kucing jantan
 - Perlu pengesahan kesahihan dari kelab asal.

12 Jika kucing yang di impot sudah hamil dari negara asal

Selain dari keperluan diatas, anda perlu syarat pengesahan bertulis dari pemilik/pembiak negara asal

13 Dalam keadaan apa kah pasangan kucing tidak dibenarkan kahwin

Ada disenaraikan di Etika Pembiak

Rujuk kepada Etika Pembiak KKM

14 Bagaimana hendak mendaftar litter dari Cattery saya

Isi borang LRF – satu borang bagi satu litter dengan tidak mengira berapa anak kucing. Pastikan pemilik 'sire' menandatangani pengesahan perkahwinan

(Sila baca panduan dan syarat syarat dibahagian atas borang. Yuran dan cara pembayaran dibahagian bawah borang)

Hantar LRF yang telah dilengkapi setelah **berumur diantara 3-6 bulan**, bersama

- Gambar anak kucing dan ibu berumur < 2 bulan dalam satu gambar *(lihat contoh)*
- Gambar anak kucing yang masih hidup berumur antar 2-3 bulan dalam satu gambar *(lihat contoh)*
- Resit sebagai bukti pembayaran yuran

(Anda Sudah memperbaharui keahlian KKM bagi tahun semasa)

maklumat tambahan bagi 'sire', jika tidak berdaftar dengan KKM

- Sijil pendaftaran dengan kenyataan pemilik
- Sijil bakatulin
- Semua sijil adalah dari Kelab pendaftaran yang terakhir
- Gambar terkini sire

(Kelulusan KKM perlu sebelum perkahwinan)



15 Bagaimana hendak mendaftar anak kucing secara individu

Isi borang CRF – bahagian A and B – satu borang bagi satu anak kucing

(Pemilik boleh atas nama pembiak atau pemilik baru)

Borang CRF boleh dihantar bersama LRF iaitu anak kucing setelah berumur minima 3 bulan

Ataupun CRF hendaklah dihantar **sebelum anak kucing berumur 1 tahun**

Hantar CRF yang telah dilengkapi bersama :

- Gambar terkini anak kucing (seperti di para 7 diatas)
- Resit bukti pembayaran yuran pendaftaran
- Pendaftaran anak-anak kucing adalah tanggungjawab pembiak, dan sijil sijil akan dikembalikan kepada pembiak untuk edaran ke pemilik baru

16 Boleh kah saya mendaftar kucing yang tiada sijil pendaftaran atau mempunyai sijil yang palsu

Boleh tapi perlu di masukan ke pertandingan antarabangsa FIFe di Kelas Novice (13a).

Perlu mendapat lapuran EXCELLENT (EX) dari 2 hakim antarabangsa FIFe

Pendaftaran adalah di pendaftaran RX

(Rujuk KKM Registration Procedures)

17 Boleh kah saya mendaftar litter dan anak kucing hasil perkahwinan dari 2 baka berlainan

Kelulusan KKM perlu terlebih dahulu, dengan menyatakan sebab perkahwinan tersebut

anda boleh mendaftarkan litter dan anak kucing (LRF and CRF) tapi perlu di masukan ke pertandingan antarabangsa FIFe di Kelas Control (13b) dengan menyatakan baka yang di matalamatkan.

Perlu mendapat lapuran EXCELLENT (EX) dari 2 hakim antarabangsa FIFe

(Rujuk KKM Registration Procedures)

18 Saya ingin membuat beberapa pembetulan/penukaran maklumat di sijil pendaftaran kucing saya

Anda perlu mengisi maklumat di bahagian bawah sijil pendaftaran. Pertukaran yang di benarkan dan yuran ada tersenarai.

Hantarkan permohonan anda beserta resit ke email registar KKM

19 Saya ingin menukar hak milik kucing yang berdaftar bawah nama saya

Anda perlu isikan butiran pemilik baru dibahagian bawah sijil pendaftaran

Hantar salinan butiran tersebut ke emel pendaftar

hantar salinan resit yuran

Gambar terkini kucing bersama pemilik baru

Sijil asal pendaftaran KKM perlu dikembalikan ke alamat seperti di sijil tersebut

Sijil pendataran yang baru akan dihantar ke pemilik baru

20 Kucing saya didaftarkan dengan kod warna yang salah

Ada 2 cara untuk membetulkan kod warna

- Dilapurkan oleh hakim di pertandingan antarabangsa FIFe
- Masuk Kelas (13c), untuk pemeriksaan 2 hakim antarabangsa FIFe

Hantarkan salinan lapuran hakim bersama resit yuran pertukaran kod warna

Semua permohonan pertukaran kod warna mesti terbukti dari genetic , atau boleh digugurkan ke pendaftaran RX.

21 Kucing saya sudah layak mendapatkan Championship Titles

Anda perlu hantar sijil CAC seperti jumlah yang diperlukan untuk mendapatkan Sijil Titles.

Title kucing anda perlu dipertingkatkan apabila sudah mendapat jumlah sijil championship yang di perlukan. Ini membolehkan kucing anda untuk bertanding di Kelas yang lebih tinggi.

Malaysian Cat Club FAQ

What you need to know about
registration and transfer of cats

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1 How to be a member

Fill the KKM Membership Form. Initial membership fees is RM50. Subsequent renewals for the following year's membership is RM30, payable by end of December of the current year.

2 How to be a FIFe Breeder

Being a FIFe Breeder is only privileged to members of FIFe affiliated Clubs, of which KKM is the Malaysian member. You need to be a member of KKM to be eligible.

Have a cat's under KKM registration at least female under the your name

You need to fill up and submit the FCR – FIFe Cattery Registration – and submit to the kkmsecreary@gmail.com

Being a KKM breeder has its rules and regulations to abide by. A good and responsible breeder should always follow the Breeders' Etiquette as a guide and in practice.

Refer to the KKM Breeders' Etiquette

3 Can I own a pedigree cat without being a KKM member or breeder?

You can own a cat registered with KKM without being a member or a breeder; you cannot however register the litter of your female cats.

4 How to transfer a cat from another Club to KKM

You need to have the following documents

An original registration certificate from the originating Club

A pedigree certificate of at least 4 generations

An ownership transfer from the previous owner from the originating Club to you. You could also have your name as the owner on the registration or pedigree certificate.

An additional ownership transfer fees will be charged if the ownership is unclear or differs from the requestor (new owner)

5 Why the need to transfer a cat from another Club to KKM

Your cat is now eligible to enter KKM organized FIFe Shows and compete for Challenge Certificate for Championship Titles.

Your litters from registered females can now be registered with KKM and be registered with a FIFe registration and pedigree certificate

6 What do I need to do

You should check on genuity by checking with the originating club **before** purchase of such cats.

KKM can assist to check on genuity. Submit the pedigree certificate and a photo of the cat in advance. Depending on the response from the originating club, this process could take some time.

7 How do I transfer cats from another club to KKM

Fill up the CRF – sections A and C

Submit the completed CRF with

- The above listed documents
- Latest photo of the cat (*see sample*)
- Latest photo of the cat with owner
- Additional photos might be requested
- Receipt of proof of fees payments



Please read the instructions and requirements at the top of the form. Fees and payment methods are stated on the CRF.

An additional ownership transfer fees will be charged if the ownership is unclear or differs from the requestor (new owner)

8 How long does it take to transfer cats from another club to KKM

All cats from foreign clubs will need authentication on genuity of their registration and pedigree. Depending on the response of the originating club, this could take some time.

Otherwise will normally take between 60 day. There is no need for a follow -up email that will cause a delays

9 What does LO or RX means on the registration number

LO – Legal Origin – when the pedigree of first 3 generations is of the same recognized breed (or sister breed) and varieties, and complete with registration numbers.

RX – Experimental – when the above conditions are not met and for novices

Both are eligible to compete for challenge certificates and championship titles in FIFe International Shows

RX cats are preferred to be bred with cats from the LO registry; however breeding with other RX cats are allowed.

10 When can I start to register my own litters

You need to fulfill the followings :

You need to have a FIFe cattery already registered with KKM

You need to be a paying KKM member for the current year

The dam (mother) of the litter is registered with KKM under your name and Cattery

The dam must have been registered with KKM before birth of litter

The cattery where the dam is registered has the right to register the litter

11 What about the sire

The sire can be registered with another Club if not with KKM, with permission from KKM **before** mating.

The following documents must be made available for authentication:

- The pedigree certificate of the sire
- Registration certificate and clear ownership
- Photo of the cat
- Need to authenticate genuity of the sire's certificates

12 The cat I imported from another Club is already pregnant

Apart from the above documentations, you also need a written confirmation from the original owner/breeder

13 Are there any restrictions to mating pairs

These are listed in the breeders' etiquette

Refer to the KKM Breeders' Etiquette

14 How do I register litters from my own Cattery

Fill up the LRF – one form for each litter regardless of the number of kittens. Ensure the owner of the sire has signed the declaration and confirm the mating.

(please read the instructions and requirements at the top of the form. Fees and method of payment are at the bottom of the form)

Submit the completed LRF **between 3-6 months** old, with

- Photo of the litter with dam before 2 months old in one photo *(see sample)*
- Photo of living kittens between 2-3 months old, in one photo *(see sample)*
- Receipt of proof of fees payments

(You need to be a current year member by paying your annual fees)

Additional documents for sire, if not registered with KKM

- Registration certificate with clear ownership
- Pedigree certificate
- All documents are from the body where the sire was last registered
- Latest photo of sire

(Permission has been given in advance prior to mating)



15 How do I register the individual kittens

Fill up the CRF – sections A and B – one form for each kitten

(The owner can be your name or the name of a new owner)

Submission of CRFs can be together with the LRF kittens with minimum age of 3 months.

Otherwise all kittens are to be registered **no later than 1 year old**.

- Current photo of the kitten *(as per article 7 above)*
- Receipt of proof of fees payment
- Registration of the individual kittens is responsibility of the breeder. The certificates will be sent to the breeder for distribution to new owners.

16 Can I register my cat if the certificates are unavailable or fake

Yes you can but you need to enter the FIFe International Show in the Novice Class (13a).

Need to obtain the qualification of EXCELLENT (EX) from 2 international FIFe Judges.

Registration will be in the RX registry

(Refer to the KKM Registration Procedures)

17 Can I register a litter and kittens from a mating of from 2 different breeds

Approval is required in advance, stating the reason for such a mating.

Yes you can register the litter and kittens (LRF and CRF) but you need to enter the FIFe International Show in the Control Class (13b) with an indication of the target breed.

Need to obtain the qualification of EXCELLENT (EX) from 2 international Judges.

(Refer to the KKM Registration Procedures)

18 I wish to make changes to my cat's certificate

You need to fill up the details of the the bottom portion of the registration certificate. Various changes that are allowed are listed.

Submit the change requests to the email stated

19 I wish to transfer to my cat to a new owner

You need to fill up the details of the new owner at the bottom portion of the registration certificate

Submit a copy of the signed off transfer information

Submit receipt as proof of payment

Latest photo of cat with new owner

Submit to the kkmregistrar@gmail.com

The original KKM certificate is to be returned to the stated address

The new certificate will be sent to the new owner

20 My cat is registered with the incorrect color code

There are 2 ways to correct your cat's color code

- Reported in the judge's report at a FIFe International Show
- Enter the Determination Class (13c), to be checked by 2 judges

Submit the judges' report with the receipt of fees for change of colour codes

All requests for color changes must be genetically proven, or risks down grading to the RX Registry

21 My cat is entitled to be awarded with Championship Titles

Need to submit the required number of CACs for Title Certificates and a fee of RM30 is applicable for each title.

The title for your cat needs to be upgraded every time you have achieved the required number of challenge certificates. This will enable your cat to compete in the next Class level.
